Volkswagen Group Dictionary - Configuring search and display languages

The new Volkswagen Group Dictionary uses the concepts of *search languages* and *display languages*.

Search languages

... are the languages in the database being searched when entering a search term.

If, for example, *German* and *English* (*US*) are configured as search languages, the term entered in the search box is searched for in both languages.


Display languages

... are the languages in a dictionary entry that are actually displayed to the user.

A lot of entries in the Volkswagen Group Dictionary not only contain terms in German and English, but also in additional languages such as, for example, Spanish, Italian or Portuguese. By configuring the display languages, users can select the languages they want to have displayed in an entry.

Example:

The search language is set to *German*. *German*, *English* (*US*), *Spanish* (*Spain*), and *Spanish* (*Mexico*) have been selected as display languages. When searching for the German term *Türen*, the corresponding entry is displayed as follows:




Configuring search and display languages

Open the *Terminology* tab.



Open the *Search settings* menu.




Click **Search language(s)** and check the languages that you want to search in.

Confirm your selection by clicking the Save button.

Click *Display language(s)* and check the languages that you want to have displayed in an entry.



Confirm your selection by clicking the *Save* button.

Important notes

It is not possible to set all available languages as search languages. This would trigger an error message.

Entries in the Volkswagen Dictionary do not always contain terms in all languages that can be selected.
